Information for the processing of personal data (customer-suppliers) pursuant to UE 2016/679 GDPR Regulations

1. Data controller

OMR S.r.l. in its capacity as Data Controller, (hereinafter referred to as "OMR") wishes to inform you that the Legislative Decree 196/03 (hereinafter the Privacy Code) and the EU Regulation 679/2016 (hereafter GDPR) govern the protection of personal data as part of their treatment activities.

2. Object of the Treatment

The processing we intend to carry out relates to your personal data, as defined by the Privacy Code and the GDPR, of which we are or of which we will be aware by virtue of the legal relations with you in existence.

3. Purpose of the Treatment

The processing of your data has the following purposes:

- a) carrying out administrative and management activities, in compliance with the fulfilment of accounting and tax obligations, and any other obligations imposed by current legislation;
- b) fulfilment of contractual and pre-contractual obligations with you;
- c) to process your requests for contact with our sales representative for the presentation of the services offered by OMR S.r.l.;
- d) marketing activities, only and exclusively behind your specific consent, aimed at market research; economic and statistical analyses; sending advertising / informative / promotional material, sending newsletters, also in relation to programs and promotions, including online, communications, development and maintenance of business relationships.

The provision of data for the purposes referred to in paragraph 3, is in some cases mandatory and the related processing, pursuant to current legislation, may be made without the consent of the person concerned. Failure to provide the same will result in our inability to fulfil and comply with the commitments undertaken in your comparisons and arising from the existing contractual or pre-contractual relationship.

The provision of data for the purposes referred to in paragraph 3, letter d) is optional and must be provided in accordance with the procedures expressly provided for in articles 23 and 130 of the Privacy Code and article 7 of the GDPR.

Communications relating to marketing activities may take place through the use of traditional methods (eg, paper mail, phone calls with operator), automated (eg, phone calls without operator) and similar (eg fax, e-mail, sms, newsletter).

If you are already a customer, we can send you commercial communications relating to services similar to those already used, except for your dissent (Article 130 c.4).

4. Treatment modality

Data processing will be carried out pursuant to art. 4 n. 2) of the GDPR, by means of the following operations: collection, registration, organization, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of data.

Your data will be processed either on paper or electronic and / or automated

Your data, starting from their receipt / update, will be kept for a reasonable period in relation to the purposes of the treatment referred to in point 3 and in any case no later than 10 years from termination of the relationship for the purposes referred to in letters a), b) and until the withdrawal of consent or until the exercise of the right of opposition for the marketing purposes referred to in letters c) and d).

5. Communication and data transfer

Your data, object of the treatment, will not be diffused; on the other hand, for the purposes referred to in point 3, they may be communicated to third parties, including commercial partners, consultants and freelancers, banks and credit institutions, insurance companies, financial companies, factoring, leasing, services, management and credit recovery, auditors, debt collection companies, public bodies, audit or supervisory bodies, to fulfil obligations deriving from the law, regulations, community regulations or for aspects concerning the management and execution of the legal relationship with you that are intercurrent or interim

Your data will be processed by the following subjects:

- Employees of OMR S.r.l., in Italy and abroad, who work as authorized persons to process data according to the tasks performed and adequately educated.
- External Managers pursuant to art. 29 of the Privacy Code and of Article 28 of the GDPR.

The list of external managers for the processing of personal data is available at the registered office of OMR S.r.l ..

For all the purposes indicated in this statement, your data may be communicated also abroad, inside and outside the European Union, in compliance with the rights and guarantees provided by the current legislation, subject to verification that the country in question guarantees an "adequate" level of protection in accordance with the provisions of the GDPR.

6. Rights of the interested party

It is specified that in your quality of interested, at any time you can ask:

- a) access to your personal data;
- b) their correction in case of inaccuracy;
- c) the cancellation of data referable to you;
- d) the limitation of treatment;
- e) the right to object to the processing of your data where the conditions are met;
- d) the right to the portability of data, ie to receive, in a structured format of common use and readable by automatic device, the personal data provided.

For anything not expressly provided for by the provisions referred to above, reference should be made to the legislation in force on the subject of Privacy and specifically to Article 7 of the Privacy Code and articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 20 and 21 of the GDPR.

It is also your right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor of personal data with its registered office in Piazza di Montecitorio n.121, 00186 Rome.

7. Withdrawal of consent

Your consent may be revoked at any time without this being able to do so:

- prejudice the lawfulness of the treatment based on the consent given before the revocation;
- to prejudice further processing of the same data based on other legal bases such as contractual or legal obligations.
